



Department of Audiology Screening Camp: Old age Home









Training programme for parents of Spastics Society of Tiruchirappalli on Oro Motor Therapy








UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - IV











UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - V










UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - VI









An Overview on Speech Language Disorders










UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - VII










Training programme for parents of on Speech, Language and Hearing disorders

The session was held through conventional face to face mode, B.ASLP II and III year, total of 50 students attended the workshop.










Inauguration of SPARC department association







One day Seminar on Anatomy of Speech Mechanism, Classification of Sounds, Place and Manner of Articulation.










One day seminar on Electro Acoustic Characteristics (EAC)

One-day Workshop on "Recent Advances in Hearing Aid Technology"








UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - IX

School screening camp, Salaipatti






One day workshop on "an overview on cochlear implants"

Thuvaravayal village camp


