




Screening Camp at Rebecca Home for Children – Thumbalam, Musiri

Orientation on Career prospects



Seminar on Basics of Neurology (Field visit)









ILAP- Audiology conference 2022






Workshop on Application of Statistics in the field of Audiology, Speech Language Pathology and Statistical methods




Workshop on Ear mould making and processing

Seminar on Real Ear Measurements









Webinar on management of Speech Sounds Disorders









NATIONAL LEVEL SEMINAR ON AUDITORY EVOKED POTENTIALS








Field Visit to ALPS on 16.02.2023




World Hearing Day Celebration and Camp
