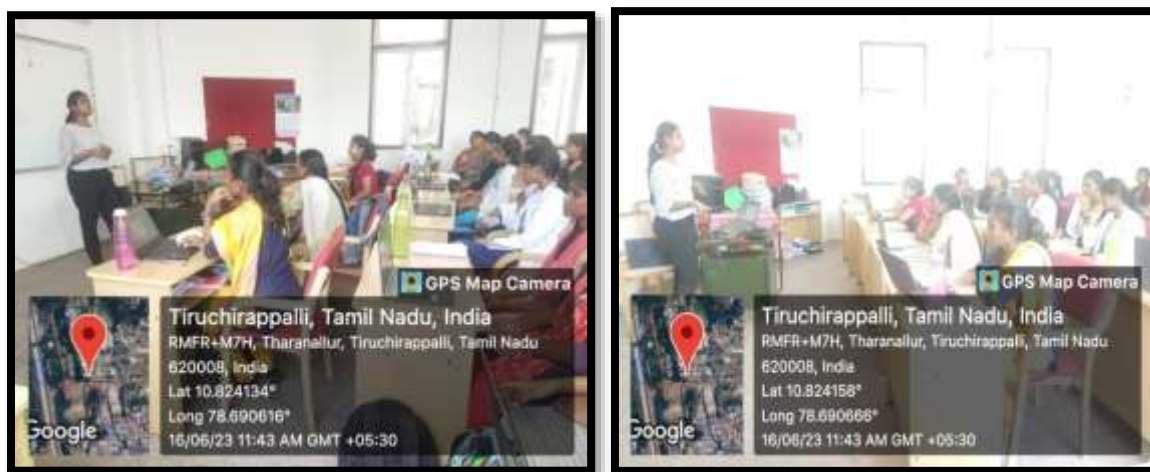

She gave an elaborated presentation on Introduction to CI, types of CI, Candidacy of CI, Features, and evaluation of cochlear implants. Demonstration was given on mapping and intra operative testing. 26 students were screened for Learning Disability and other related issues. Further recommendations were given to the students concerned. Counselling was given to all students

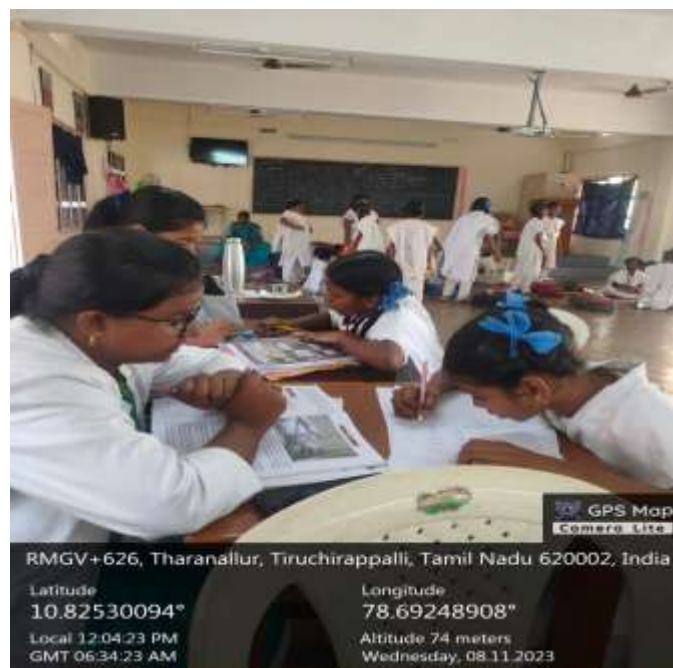

### Maxillary Augmented Prosthesis

- The remaining function of the residual tongue is traced with softened modeling compound material. With the aid of the speech pathologist, the patient is asked to repeat the linguvolar sounds /v/ and /g/ for the posterior palatal tracing and the lingualvolar sounds /d/ and /t/ for the anterior palatal tracing. Pressure-indicating paste is used to show the areas of contact.

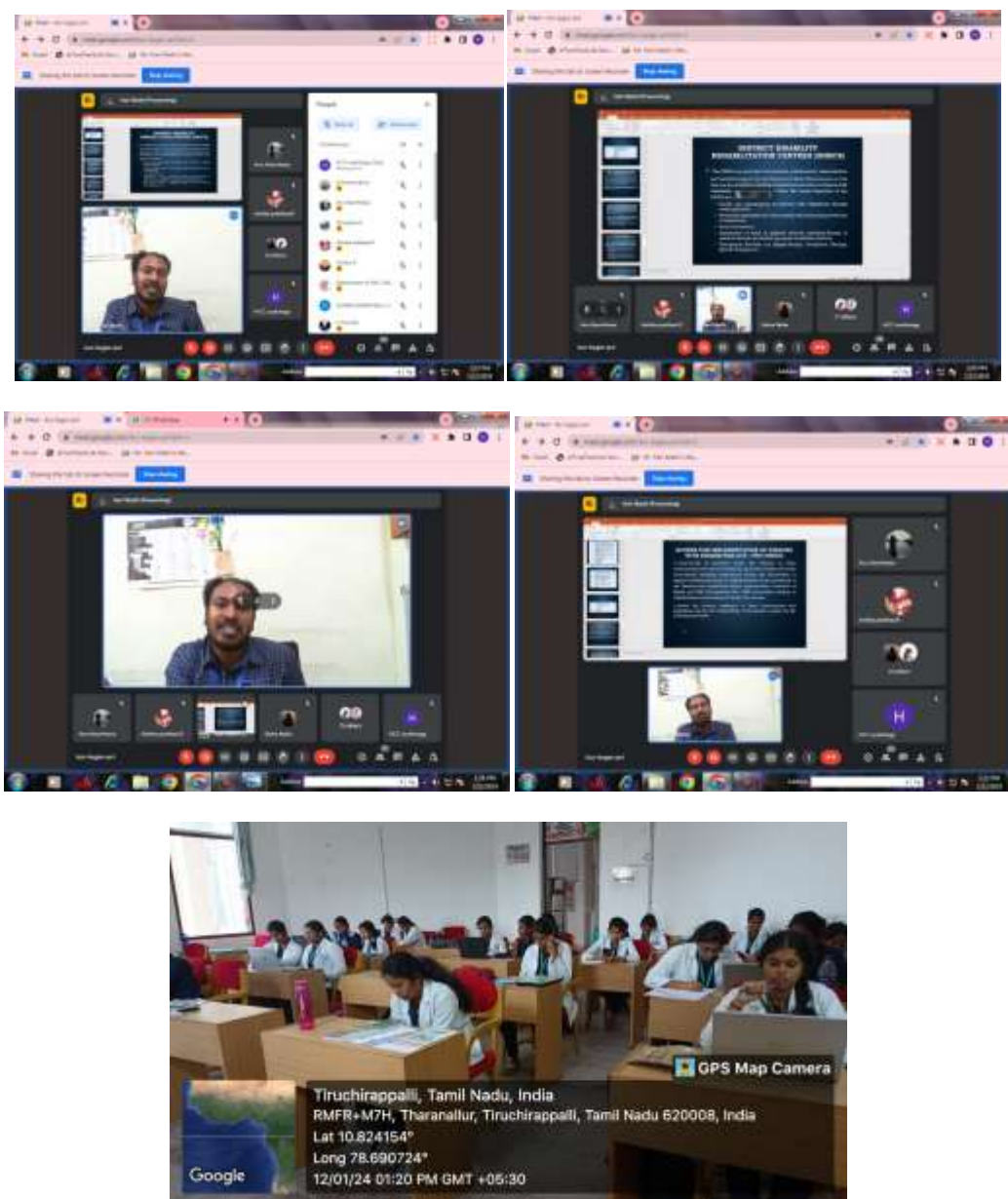

## ORIENTATION PROGRAM ON “ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN ON 15th FEBRUARY 2024

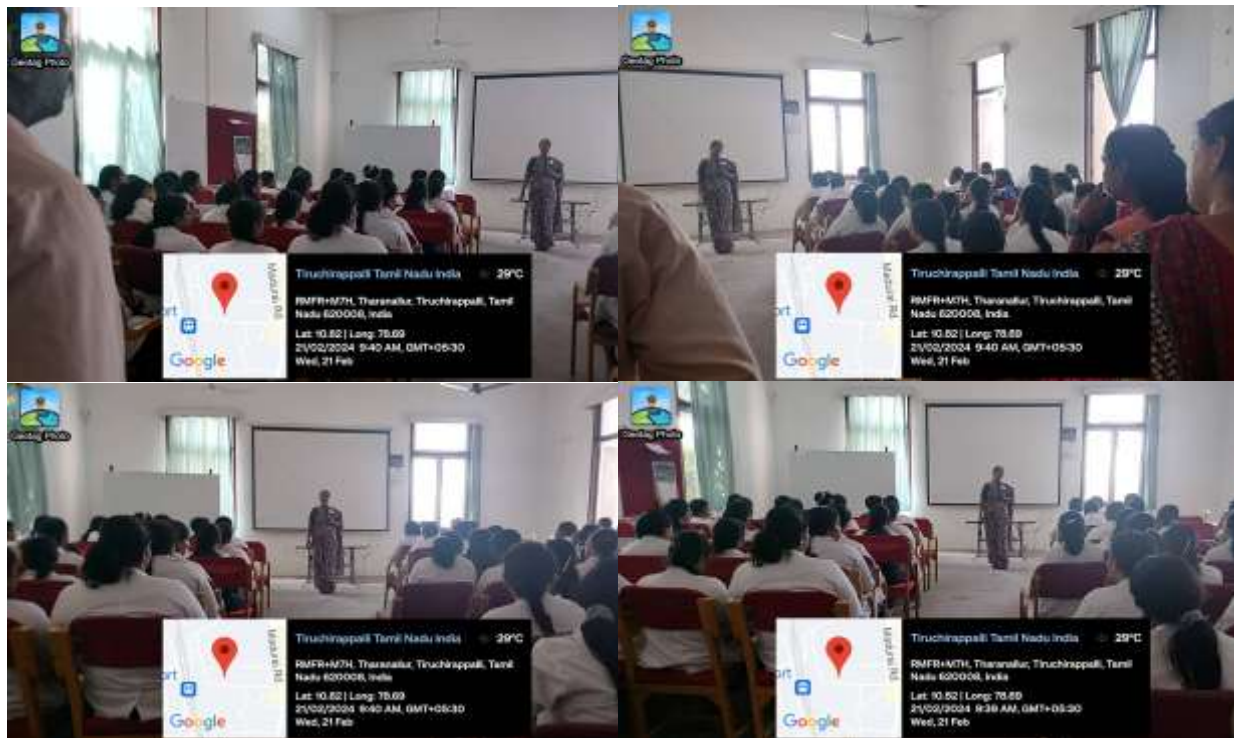

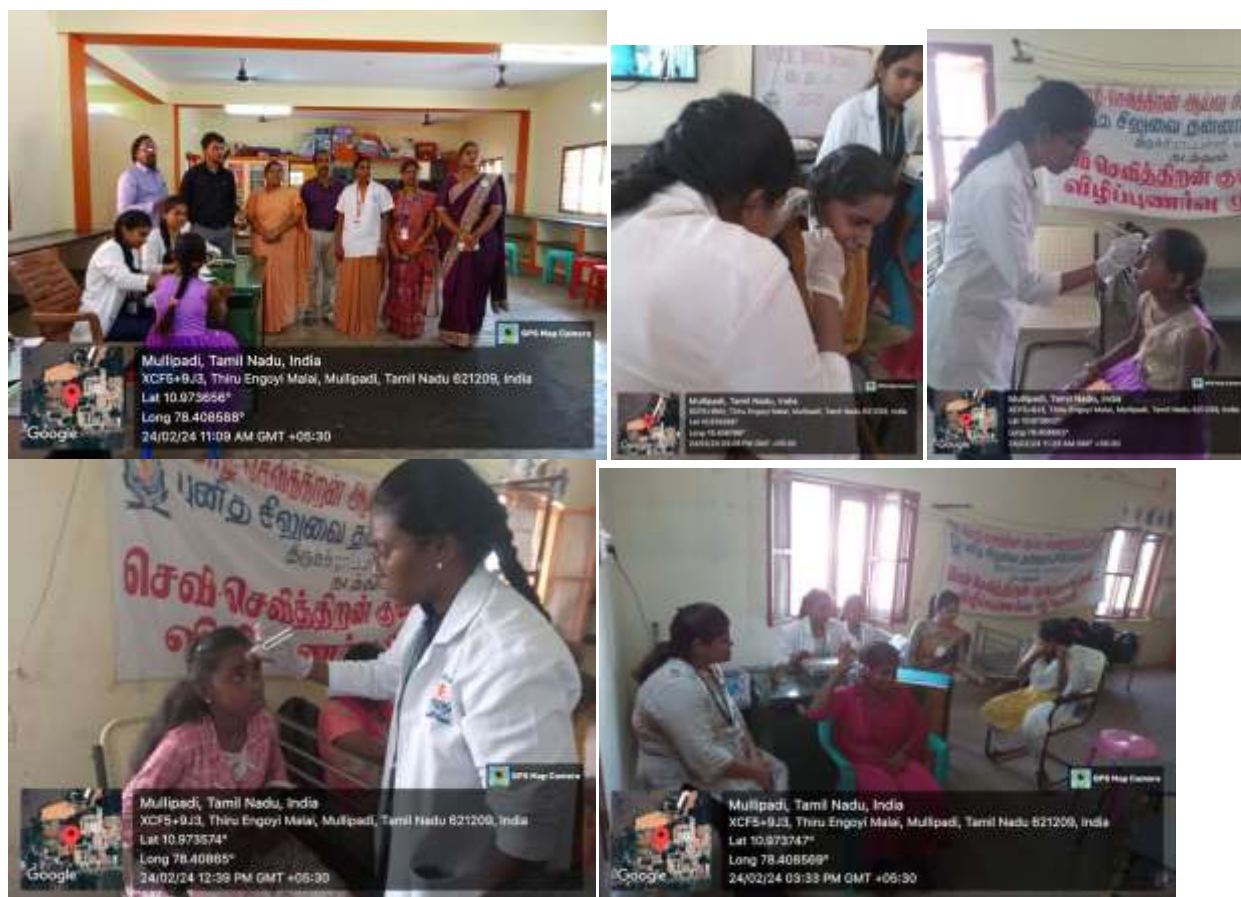

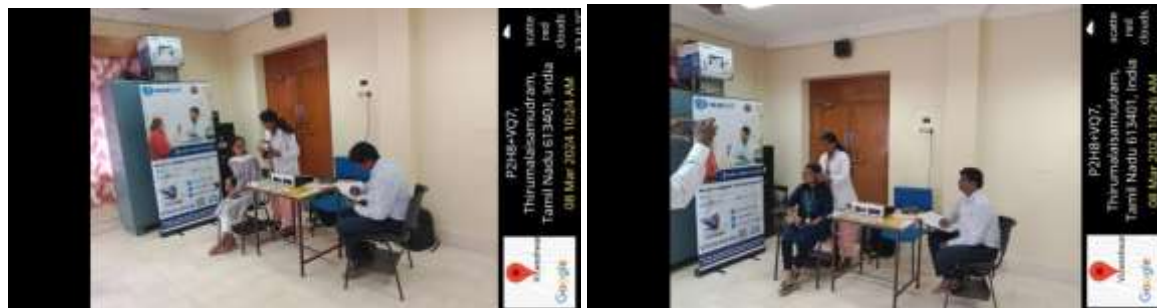
### **HEARING SCREENING CAMP at Union Bank, Trichy on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024.**

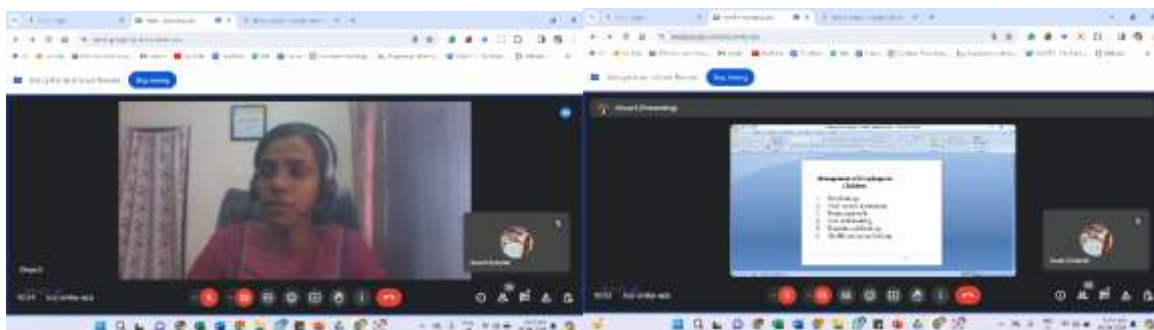






### UNLEASH out – house Webinar series - 23
