# Inauguration of the Botany Association - 8.7.2019



#### Twodays workshop on "Nursery techniques" - 9.1.2020 & 10.1.2020

The PG and Research Department of Botany organized 2 days workshop on "Nursery techniques" on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. The workshop was inaugurated by Mr. P. Thomas, Rtd. Sub-divisional Engineer, BSNL. The programme was started with a prayer service by PG students. Dr. P. Shanthi, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Botany, Holy Cross College, Trichy welcomed the gathering and she also briefed about the workshop. Around 77 studens from UG, PG and research scholars of Botany department of Holy Cross College, Trichy were enthusiastically participated. The chief guest Mr. P. Thomas, delivered the inaugural address on the "Importance of trees and gardens". He gave an overview about the trees and gardens of India and native species of our country and Trichy. He also shared his knowledge and experience in propagating trees and herbal plants. The basic nursery techniques and propagation methods like was explained by Mr. P. Thomas.

In the afternoon session, he gave live demonstration of propagation techniques of nurseries like grafting, layering and budding. During the practical session hands on training was given to the students. Each student prepared individual nursery packets and they learned the different nursery techniques like mixing the soil, filling the pots and transplanting the plants. Students also trained with different nursery propagation techniques like layering, grafting and budding.

On the second day of the workshop he gave an awareness talk on the present environmental status of India and discussed the current data of forest cover and vegetation of TamilNadu. He also highlighted that preserving native plant species and growing more plants inturn increases annual rainfall. He also explained the social, economical and ethical values of star plants and other oxygen yielding plants.

The resource person for the second session was Dr. Janet Rajeswari, an entrepreneur in organic farming. Dr. M. Revathi, Assistant Professor of Botany, Holy Cross College, Trichy

introduced the chief guest and welcomed the gathering. Dr. Janet Rajeswari gave a live demonstration on vermicomposting and discussed the different methods of vermicomposting. She also instructed the participants about the techniques to overcome all the possible practical difficulties while doing vermicompost. Students were eagerly learned all the techniques and gave positive feedback. The valediction for the workshop was held at 2.00 p.m in Botany UG lab. Mr. P.
