

The Post Graduate & Research Department of Rehabilitation Science, Holy Cross College, Tiruchirappalli has envisaged the noble mission of education and training effective manpower to help Persons with Special Needs in society. The department offers Diploma, Undergraduate, Postgraduate, Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D) and need based courses to build a cadre of professionals to work with all categories of persons with disabilities. It is also a Study Centre for B. Ed special education (Intellectual Disability) offered by Tamil Nadu Open University, Chennai through Open & Distance Learning mode in collaboration with Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi. Ever since its inception, the department has strengthened its knowledge, training and research by networking with many local, national and international agencies using mutual expertise and resources in various forms.

SOC SEAD takes various measures to support the suffering humanity through various developmental and rehabilitation projects such as Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts, Family Counselling Centre, Individual and Community Based Rehabilitation supported by the Catholic Health Association of India (CHAI), Adoption Centre, Community College, Creches, Self-help Groups, Vocational Training for Children with Special Needs, Sponsorship program for the education of the poor children, Promotion of Roof Garden, Support for the education of young girls and promoting environmental degradation and income generation for women by Areca Plate Production Unit. These Centers are ways to alleviate poverty, addressing the problems of children, bringing the broken families together, welfare services to the children and youngsters with disability, promoting environment, providing De-toxification treatment and therapeutic services to the addicts and providing day care services to the children of working mothers.

The Post Graduate and Research Department of Rehabilitation Science, Holy Cross College, Tiruchirappalli and SOC SEAD, Tiruchirappalli enter into this agreement of co-operation to establish and collaborate in areas of mutual interest and benefit with reference to strengthening and promoting co-operation in the areas of education and rehabilitation of persons with special needs. Based on principles of equity and reciprocity this agreement will serve as a general framework for co-operation between our two institutions.

OBJECTIVES AND FORMS OF CO-OPERATION

1. To utilize the expertise of professionals from both institutions to enhance and equip students and research scholars with the emerging perspectives in the field of disability.
2. To facilitate research in the field of disability and rehabilitation.
3. To conduct need-based courses and programmes with participation from both the institutions.
4. To collaborate educational and vocational training and placement services and programmes for children and adults with special needs.
5. To identify areas of interest and enhance knowledge and experience of our students and research scholars.
6. To undertake institution visits, internship/placement and in-service training programmes for enriching the knowledge and skills of our students and research scholars.
7. To identify and utilize resources like therapy materials, reading materials, books, audio visual equipments, ICT – equipments and other resourceful materials in the area of disability and rehabilitation.
8. To participate in academic conferences, seminars, workshop and discussions held by either institute.

COMMENCEMENT, RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

1. This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. It may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partners.
2. If either partner wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the five years period it must notify the other not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOU.
3. This agreement or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.
