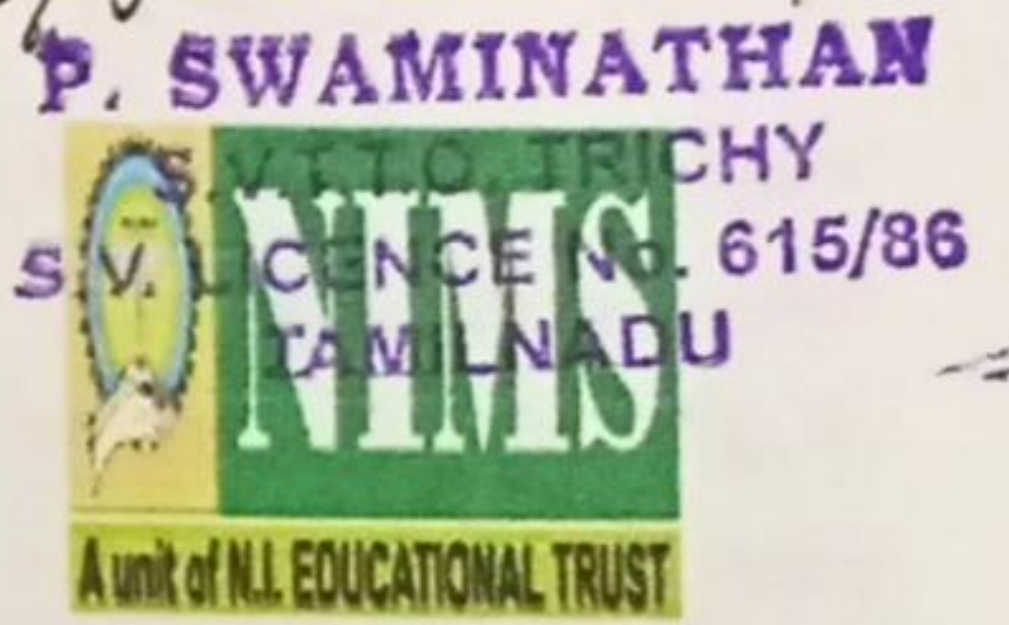

The department offers Diploma, Undergraduate, Postgraduate, Philosophy of Doctrate (Ph. D) and need based courses to build a cadre of professionals to work with all categories of persons with disabilities. Ever since its inception, the department has strengthened its knowledge, training and research by networking with many local, national and international agencies using mutual expertise and resources in various forms.

OBJECTIVES AND FORMS OF CO-OPERATION


1. To utilize the expertise of professionals from both institutions to enhance and equip students and research scholars with the emerging perspectives in the field of disability.

7. To participate in academic conferences, seminars, workshop and discussions held by either institute.


COMMENCEMENT, RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

1. This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. It may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partners.

2. If either partner wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the five years period it must notify the other not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOU.
3. This agreement or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.




