Either party may use the name, registered trademarks, service marks, logos, insignia or any other proprietary designation (collectively the "Marks") of the other Party or its products or services with the other Party's prior written approval, however, nothing in this MOU shall be deemed, construed or interpreted as granting to either Party any right to use any of the Marks, products or services of the other Party. While using the said Marks, the party which uses the said Marks, shall comply at all times with the current version of the applicable mark and logo guidelines of the other party without any fail.

Confidentiality:

Neither party shall publicize this MOU and the annexes thereto, the provisions herein or related subject matter to any third party unless agreed to in writing by the other party. The parties agree that any proprietary business and/or technical information or material received orally or in writing and which is designated as "Confidential" or similar restrictive legend (hereinafter "Confidential Information") provided in connection with this MOU will be held and maintained in confidence, including this MOU and its annexes, and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the prior written consent of the disclosing party. The obligation upon the parties to protect the Confidential Information of the other under this MOU shall survive any expiration or termination of the relationship between the parties for any reason.

Governing Law, Jurisdiction and Dispute Resolution:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive Central and State laws of India. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts between or among the parties arising out of or relating with this agreement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Gurugram.

In the event a dispute arises in connection with the validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged breach of this MOU, the parties shall attempt in the first instance to resolve such dispute through negotiation. If the dispute is not resolved through negotiation then either party may refer the dispute for resolution to the Arbitration under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any subsequent enactment or amendment thereto, and the decision of the Arbitrator (whom shall be jointly appointed by both the parties) shall be binding upon both the parties. The seat of Arbitration shall be at Gurugram. The language of arbitration shall be English. The provisions of this Article shall survive the term/termination of this Agreement. 
Partial Invalidity:

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

General Agreement for Cooperation

- To facilitate technical and logistical support for the conduct of sports programmes and related events for persons with intellectual disabilities and unified partners.
- To permit the use of the **Special Olympics Bharat – Tamil Nadu logo** by the Post Graduate & Research Department of Rehabilitation Science, Holy Cross College, **solely for academic, training, awareness, and promotional purposes** related to activities under this MoU, subject to prior approval and adherence to branding guidelines of Special Olympics Bharat – Tamil Nadu.

Article 3: Activities to be Performed

Responsibilities of Party No. 1:

2. To train faculty members of the College as master trainers to promote Special Olympics activities.
3. To collaborate with the partner institution to identify and select trainees through campus-based programmes.
4. To consider the participation of trained unified partners, coaches, and volunteers in Regional, National, and International Special Olympics events, subject to eligibility and regulations.

Article 4: Effectiveness

This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signing by the authorized representatives of both parties.

Article 5: Term and Termination

- This MoU shall remain in force for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of signing.
