The KE CA TO CLE awareness campaign began with a simple interaction with the campus sanitary staff, who revealed their horrifying plight over unkept toilet etiquettes and unpreserved sanitization among the student body. Despite the fact that the gravity of the problem looked to be modest and trivial at first, it quickly escalated and became the talk of the campus. The in-campus revolutionary effect took flight on February 7, 2022, during a small gathering at the HCC Studio. A group of Student Council members were notified on the rising toilet sanitization concern by Ms. Shirley Deepak, Media House and Dr. Anita, Assistant Professor of the Department of Social Work. The student council members expressed their views and shared ideas on how to expand the range of the campaign to bring a long-lasting effect among the student community.
