Minutes

The meeting began with a short prayer.

The Principal Dr. Sr. Christina Bridget welcomed the committee members. The coordinators of the respective committees presented an assessment report of the activities accomplished for the last five years 2014 to 2019.

The Research criterion Core Committee member Dr. M. Rajalakshmi presented the developments in the area of Research and Innovation for the past five years

Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, has been producing challenging research for more than a decade with a cluster of high intellectual and analytical expertise. Our novel ideas and techniques in diversified fields lead us to reach many achievements through well-equipped laboratories.

Center for Research and Development (CRD) of our Institution acts as driving force for a paradigm shift of basic research into innovative applied research and transfer of knowledge. A blend of CRD, Crossian Institute for Collaborative Research and Sustainable Development (CICRSD), Innovation and Entrepreneurial Cell (IEC)" creates a common podium for sharing innovative ideas and discussing the mode of implementation. We have 13 recognized Research centers and mobilized nearly 3.9 crores of funds through various projects and schemes.



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We have recently received one more patent for novel phyto-compound along with the process, published four patent ideas on, "Public Transport Tracker, Automatic Accident Detector and Life Saver, IOT Based Coal Mine Safety Monitoring System with GPS Tracking and Smart Bio-degradable and Non- Bio Degradable Waste Management" and developed a database *called DaiCee*. We follow a code ethics for research & publications with below 12% Plagiarism through URKUND software. 59 research supervisors in 13 disciplines are mentoring for Ph D and produced 62 Doctorates. We have 832 publications in reputed Journals which enhance the citation index and h index of the Institution and 546 Books/Chapters/Proceedings.

Seed grant has been provided to the Management Staff for an amount of Rs. 4, 24, 200/-to 69 Staff members during this assessment period to enable them to pursue quality research and publish their research findings in Web of Science and Scopus indexed Journals.

We have established Research Endowment award namely Late Dr P Daisy Gold medal oration award for 2 lakh rupees where the awardee will be given a citation and a gold medal and Dr. Sr. Dona Best Researcher Award for the Outstanding Faculty and Research Scholar, every academic year. The protocol developed by our students and scholars was got selected in Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2019 and in BDU-AIU, Students Research Convention at Bharathidasan University.

Our next five year road map on research would lead us to establish nodal centers for research and Institution would become *Centre for Excellence*.

The Alumnae Representative Ms. G. Praveena Carmel, on listening to the presentation by Dr. M. Rajalakshmi suggested that Research Projects can also be collaborated with Special Education focusing on Children with Autism. Several mini projects were identified to be done by both the Faculty of Biological and Rehabilitation Science.

The CSR Personnel Dr. Y. Joe, also highlighted the need for a social Audit to make the projects relevant and focus on collaborative Research with peer reviewed research institutions and those of National repute like CCMB, IISC, BIOCON, Tata Institute of Social Sciences and Azim Premji foundation.

Dr. Horne Iona Averal, the Dean of Science presented the highlights of the Curriculum Criterion with the changes and updates in the Curriculum since 2014, and the curriculum structure and pattern which included papers on Gender Studies, Environmental Sustainability and Professional Ethics offered in the various programmes.

Dr. Y. Joe, the External Expert and CSR Personnel suggested to include courses on digital technology and also to add contents like climate change, global warming and mitigation adaptations. With regard to curriculum Sir, enforced the fact to set quantitative outcome indicators. He stressed the importance of processing from Baseline Objectives to move towards

the Output (Marks) and finally the outcome which facilitated the student progression to higher studies of employment.

Dr. Sujatha Ilangovan made a presentation on the Extension Programme – RESCAPES of our College with regard to its origin operative Mechanism, Objectives, Milestones, Activities and Achievements since 2014 – 2019.

The Expert Dr. C.D. Lethi suggested to plan out check out mechanisms and establish linkages with accredited laboratories for adapting screening procedures in children and adults of adopted villages. Different target groups to be included and the areas like Education, Sanitation, Malnourishment, Nutrition aspects also to be included in the community awareness and intervention programmes. All facets of the village community to be focused to develop a Holy Cross Model village in the Intervention Process of the RESCAPES Project were agreed by all the members present.

The External Experts expressed the importance of identifying and mobilizing local resources and build on them to evolve community participation among the village population.

The Experts also suggested developing the seasonal resources available in the community and awareness to be given based on the prevalence of seasonal diseases and infections and Educational materials to be prepared by the college students and distributed based on the need and occurrence of diseases etc.

Dr. Mary Mejrullo Merlin, the Coordinator of the E-Content Development Center briefed us about the advancements in E-Content development focusing on preparation of Video and E-Lessons by the faculty. The various workshops and training programmes organized to train the faculty for ICT mode of teaching was outlined and she also presented

Those 11 E-content proposals have been sent. The experts suggested that Faculty Blogs can be developed where they can post the academic writing, E-content and Video lessons. Text books with Quick Reference (QR) code were to be included and interactive software to be made use of in the Teaching Learning Process, which will be of great benefit to the student community.

Dr. A. Turin Martina, the IQAC Coordinator thanked the Experts, Alumnae Representative and Committee members for their active participation and valuable suggestions, involvement and commitment in the academic progress of the various initiatives undertaken for Quality Enhancement in the College.
