LIBRARY

The Holy Cross College library, established in 1923, is one of the most well-equipped libraries in Tamil Nadu. It houses 1,252 rare books, some dating back to 1840, covering subjects like Literature, History, Economics, and Science. The library also offers access to 130,622 books, 148 periodicals, and various e-resources such as DELNET, NLIST, and Web of Science. It is an institutional member of the National Digital Library (NDL) and NPTEL, providing students and staff with online courses. The library's digital features include an E-library with subscribed journals, e-books, and MOOCs, as well as an institutional repository storing video lessons, research theses, and ancient documents. Plagiarism checks are conducted using Turnitin for research work. The library supports economically disadvantaged students with a Book Bank scheme, and offers reprography services. Additionally, department libraries are available in various disciplines like Mathematics, Physics, and English.
