

Cyclone MICHAUNG hit Tamil Nadu and Kerala by 2nd December 2023 and due to this various places, people and livestock were greatly affected in both states.

Religious and Sisters always support people who are facing difficulties and our Sisters of Cross of Chavanod, Tiruchirappalli Province, Holy Cross College (Autonomous) Tiruchirappalli, always step forward in such situations of natural disasters, to lend a helping hand and support the affected people.

Our college Principal Rev. (Sr.) DR.I. RAJAKUMARI, P. called for an emergency meeting with the staff of various Clubs and Extension department on 11th December 2023 and had a brainstorming session for the emergency relief work. A team was formed and was named as "HOLY CROSS EMERGENCY RELIEF TEAM"

The relief items to be distributed were listed thus:

- 1. 5Kg Rice
- 2. ½ Kg Sugar
- 3. ½ Kg Split Gram Lentils
- 4. ½ Kg Algae Lentils
- 5. ½ Kg Tea leaf packet
- 6. 1Bed Sheet
- 7. 1Mat

The team members were divided into small groups and items were brought within a challenging speed of time. All the above relief items were collected and the packing was done great speed.

Volunteers, and the Relief Team members were involved in packing and placing the materials in vehicle.

1200 relief items were packed and shifted to the lorry and the relief team started for Chennai on 12th December 2023 by 3.30 a.m.

Following them a team of Sisters, Staff and Emergency Relief Team Members started for the relief providing area in the college van.

The emergency relief team was divided into two teams. The first Team was guided by FR.RAJ and MS. SHALINI at Chennai and the team reached Pattinapakkam Fisher Folk area, where MRS. REVATHI, COUNSELLOR supported the Sister, Staff and Students in distributing the relief materials to 700 affected families.

MR.T. VELU., B.A., L.L.B., MLA., also participated in the distribution of relief materials to the needy.

The second team was guided by FR. JOSEPH LEO, MR. BIJU AND MS. LENI, and the team reached Chemmanacheri area and distributed the relief materials to 500 affected families.

Service extended to other taluk on need basis. For the first time we extended our service to Tribal area (Pachamalai) Speech, Language and Hearing Screening was conducted at Odaikaittopudur Government Tribal High School on 10th July 2023 by which 137 were screened. And on 11th July 2023 Speech and language screening was conducted at Top Sentaittopatti, Government Tribal Higher Secondary School by which 350 were screened and then Rehabilitation Science Department students conducted disability assessment by which 170 school students from 6th, 7th and 8th standards were screened.




Blood grouping, Hb (gms) finding, BMI Calculation-Day-2












