Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, is a highly reputed arts and science college for women in the state of Tamil Nadu, situated in the heart of "The Rock City." Holy Cross College has a unique history of academic excellence. It is a Catholic institution established in 1923 and has been at the forefront of women's education for 100 years, celebrating its historic achievements in all areas of excellence. It is one of the oldest colleges for women in South India and is affiliated with Bharathidasan University. The college is administered by the Congregation of the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod, Tiruchirappalli Province. In recognition of its services to the cause of women's education, the college was granted Autonomous status in 1987 by Bharathidasan University. It was accredited by NAAC in 1999 with five stars and reaccredited in 2005 with an 'A' grade. With recognition from the UGC as a "College with Potential for Excellence" in 2011, the college was awarded an 'A' grade with a score of 3.5 on a 4-point scale by NAAC in 2012. In 2020, the college was awarded an A++ grade by NAAC with a CGPA of 3.75 on a 4-point scale.

- Obscence and offensive performances will be rejected outright.
- A student can participate in only one event.
- The participants should strictly adhere to the timings of the various events.
- The decision of the judges for every event will be final.
