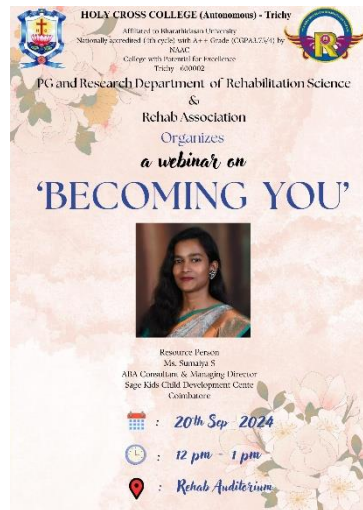

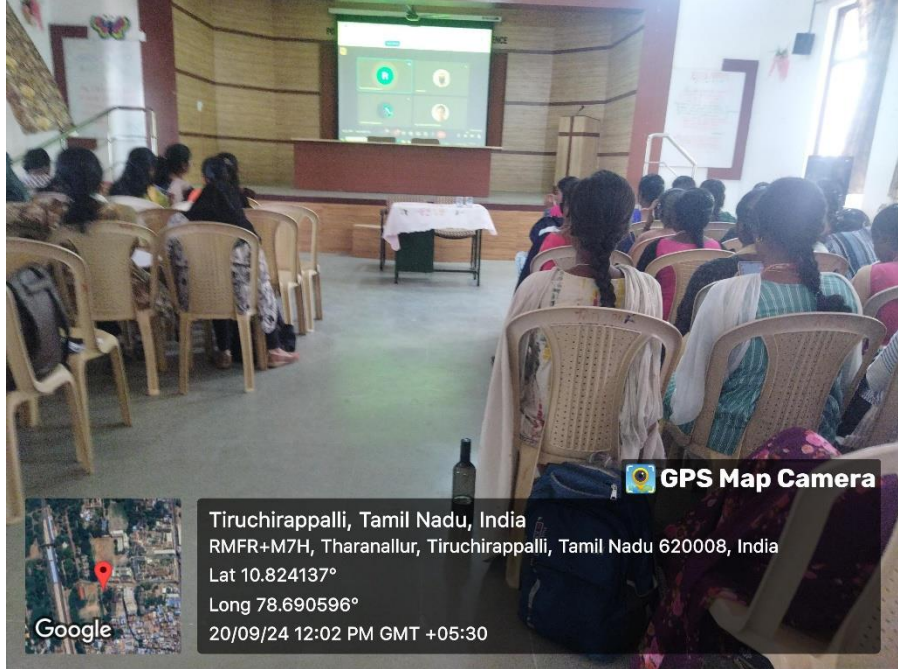
A Report on the Webinar ‘BECOMING YOU’
